Special Education in Ethics (SEE)

1.Philosophical ethics classes are available in all NSW public schools for K-6 children.

2.Ethics classes teach children how to evaluate evidence and use reasoning to make decisions. Primary Ethics is the non-profit organisation appointed by the NSW State Government to provide curriculum.

3.Ethics classes are held each week at the same time as Special Religious Education (SRE, also sometimes known as Scripture). Children not enrolled in either SRE or SEE are supervised during this time.
